U.S. FINANCIAL AID TABLE 2009 - AVAILABLE EXCLUSIVELY AT EDUCATIONUSA ADVISING CENTERS

This year's financial aid table features a total of **886 regionally accredited** 4-year universities and colleges in the United States.

The table lists all schools that have awarded at least **\$10,000 to at least one international student**. Approximately 40% of the 2,000 4-year schools in the U.S. have earned places on the list.

Undergraduate financial aid is not “rarer than hen's teeth”. However, these days, \$10,000 doesn't go very far. What is more impressive is that 352 schools have awarded more than \$20,000 to internationals.

Here is the final count:

More than \$60,000:	1 institution
\$50,000-\$60,000:	50
\$40,000-\$50,000:	44
\$30,000-\$40,000:	71
\$20,000-\$30,000:	186

Over 350 schools award more than \$20,000, and almost 100 schools award more than \$40,000. A total of **85 colleges and universities regularly award full funding** (covering tuition, fees, and living expenses) **to international students who use EducationUSA centers**. The table is for undergraduate funding for non-US citizens and does not include athletic or sports scholarships.
